he had an attack of pleurisy in right side. He was in Hospital for 3 weeks. Appeared before a medical board Jan. 6/17 and was granted 2 months sick leave for the purpose of returning to Canada. This leave expired March 15 th 1917. He appeared before another medical board at Base Hospital Toronto on Feb. 27/17 and was granted 4 months further extension of his sick leave from March 15/17 to July 15/17.

PRESENT CONDITION.

Weight is about normal. -158 - Pulse, -80 - He sleeps well but appears to be always tired. Nutrition is good and his chest is well ~~developed~~ formed and regular. He appears to be rather pale. Expansion $36\frac{1}{2}$ x $38\frac{3}{4}$. Apices clear. Kronigs isthmus narrow right and left. Expiration sound over right upper lobe a little enlarged and roughened. Slight decrease in resonance. No notable change in auscultation. Vocal fremitus and resonance but little changed. There is suspicion of old Hilus tuberculosis (right) with some spread into right upper lobe. Inactive. He has a persistent cough. He expectorates not more than a $\frac{1}{4}$ cup of sputum in mornings. He has no night sweats. On any slight provocation he perspires easily. He can walk one mile without tiring. His condition has improved.

He was in hospital for 10 days during April 1917 for an acute infection of right arm. There is a rough scar $\frac{1}{2}$ at base of right thumb where hand has

The opinion of the Board upon the questions herein is as follows: -

- (1) Is the officer fit for service? * No. (hospital there are 2 large and several small furunculi)
- (2) If not so fit, how long is the disability likely to continue? (in evidence.)

The disability is likely to continue for 4 months.

RECOMMENDATIONS.

We recommend that he be given 4 months extension of sick leave from July 15/17 to November 15/17 for the purpose of further treatment. (Rest and Fresh Air.) Sanitarium Treatment advised.

above-named officer and find that while in France in December, 1916, he had an attack of pleurisy in the right side. Was in Hospital for three weeks. Appeared before Medical Board January 6th, 17, and was granted two months leave of absence to return to Canada, leave expiring March 15th/17.

PRESENT CONDITION:- Weight is about normal - 158 lbs. - pulse 70, always tired but sleeps well. Nutrition good, chest well formed and regular, rather pale. Expansion poor. Apices not fully resonant, note over right upper lobe, apex to 3rd. space is definitely short. Kronig's isthmus, narrow right and left. Right infra scapula and infra axillary regions not fully resonant. No adventitious sounds, no notable change in auscultation. Vocal fremitus and vocal resonance but little changed. There is evidence of atelectasis T.B. Rt. with some spread into right upper lobe, inactive but may become so if Bronchitis is not controlled. Persistent cough.

The opinion of the Board upon the questions herein is as follows:-

(1) Is the officer fit for service? No.

(2) If not so fit, how long is the disability likely to continue? Four months.

RECOMMENDATION:- That he be granted an extension of leave for four months from March 15th to July 15th, 1917.

Sanatorium treatment suggested if treatment is to be carried out under Military direction.

(3) To what extent does it prevent his earning a livelihood? 3/5 at present.

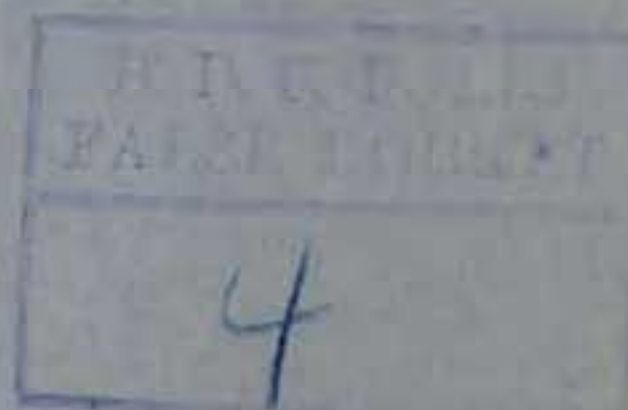
